









#### Factors driving investment to KSA agrifood sector




- (1) Priority sector for Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030 strategy
- Government's commitment to boost self-sufficiency in the sector, creating opportunities to localize production

**Key growth drivers** 

Accelerated population growth (+3.6% expected) driven by attraction of expats and growing number of tourists & pilgrims

Lifestyle changes and a growing participation of women in the workforce (+10% CAGR) are driving demand for convenient and processed food, often higher priced than cooking ingredients

Gradual shift of demand to food categories perceived as healthy driven by increasing health consciousness of Saudi consumers


